

YAITA PRIVACY POLICY

At **Yaita** we are committed to protecting and preserving your privacy when visiting our site or communicating electronically with us.

Whenever you provide information, we are legally obliged to use your information in line with all laws concerning the protection of personal information.

This Privacy Policy, together with our terms of use, provides an explanation as to what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you.

Why we collect personal information about you

We will only require you to provide personal information to us where it is necessary for us to provide you with a service at your request.

We may use the information for the following purposes:

- To provide information on other products which we feel may be of interest to you, where you have consented to receive such information.
- To notify you about any changes to our website, such as improvements or service/product changes, that may affect our service.

In operating our website, we may collect and process the following data about you:

- Details of your visits to our website and the resources that you access, including: traffic data, location data, cookies, weblogs and other communication data.

Information Collected by Third Parties

Payment information is processed by our payment service provider.

- In addition to information collected by ourselves then we may also receive data that has been collected by third parties, which would be added to the previous information held by ourselves.

Use of your Information

We collect information about you in order to process your order and deliver our service to you.

This data will not be passed onto any third parties, other than for payment processing and service fulfillment.

If you are an existing customer, we may contact you with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of previous sales to you.

Storing your data

We will take all reasonable steps to make sure that your data is treated securely and in agreement with this Privacy Policy. Data that is provided to us is stored on our secure servers. Details relating to any transactions entered into on our site will be encrypted to ensure its safety. The transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure and therefore we cannot guarantee the security of data sent to us electronically and transmission of such data is therefore entirely at your own risk. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password so that you can access certain parts of our site, and or applications, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential.

Disclosing Your Information

Where applicable, we may disclose your personal information to any member of our group. This includes, where applicable, our subsidiaries, our holding company and its other subsidiaries (if any). We may also disclose your personal information to third parties:

1. Where we sell any or all of our business and/or our assets to a third party.
2. To assist fraud protection and minimize credit risk.
3. Where we are legally required to disclose your information.

Cookies

To help us improve our website and the service we provide to you we may use technology to track the patterns of behavior of visitors to our site. Often, this is in the form of a cookie file. Where used, these cookies are downloaded to your computer or device automatically.

On occasion, we may gather information about your computer for our services and to provide statistical information regarding the use of our website to our advertisers. The information collected in this way can be used to identify you unless you modify your browser settings.
